



Veterinary-Client-Patient Relationship (VCPR)

To establish and maintain a valid Veterinary-Client-Patient Relationship,
the following conditions must be met:

1. The veterinarian has assumed responsibility for making medical judgments regarding the health of the animal(s)
and
has discussed any treatment needed with the client,
including providing instructions on administering drugs or
treatment.
2. The veterinarian has examined the animal(s) and is personally acquainted with the care of the animal(s).

This examination must have taken place within a medically appropriate time with a maximum of one year.
