Keeping Pets Safe On Halloween

Halloween has become a festive holiday that often involves elaborate decorations, candles, parties, and tasty treats. As with most holiday's, Halloween requires pet owners to consider their pet's safety. Keep candy wrappers and lollipop sticks out of your pet's reach, as they can be a choking hazard. Chocolate and xylitol (sugar alcohol sweetener) are toxic to dogs and cats and therefore should be kept safely out of reach. Keep jack-o-lanterns and other lit decorations out of reach so your pet can't tip them over. Consider keeping your pet in a separate room during trick or treating time so your pet doesn't become anxious or frightened with the extra doorbell chimes, added activity, and scary costumes.
