Every patient is examined prior to any surgical procedure. This will aid the doctor in determining if your pet is healthy to undergo general anesthesia and surgery.

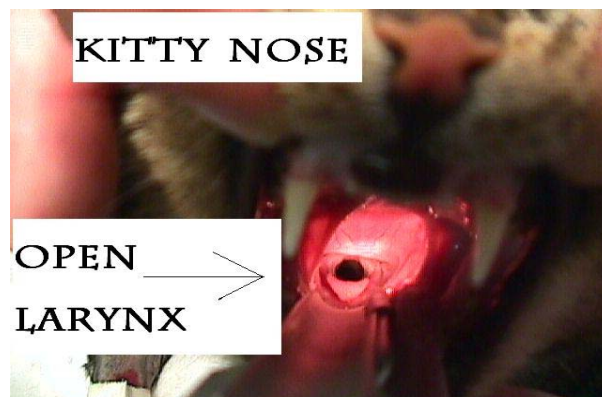
We provide pre-anesthetic blood work to evaluate your pets internal health status prior to anesthesia and surgery.



IV catheter placement and fluid therapy are highly recommended during anesthetic procedures. This aids your pet by maintaining healthy blood pressure and providing access to the vascular system in case of an emergency situation.



All anesthetized patients are intubated to maintain an open airway and deliver the oxygen/anesthetic agent needed for the surgical procedure.





All procedures under anesthesia are monitored by a registered veterinary technician.
